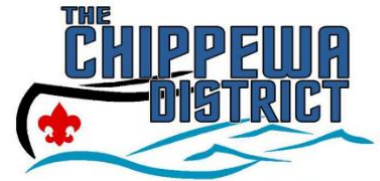


2019 Unit Award of Appreciation Unit Selection Form

General Information

- 1: The Unit Award of Appreciation is presented by the District on behalf of the unit.
- 2: The award is available to adult volunteers who render service of an outstanding nature at the unit level.
- 3: The award is made available on the basis of one (1) for each unit.
- 4: It is not recommended to nominate an adult volunteer who has already received this award.
- 5: Submission of this selection form does not register the recipient to attend the district dinner, the unit is responsible for properly registering the recipient (and guest, per unit discretion) to attend the district dinner.

Requirements

- 1: A nominee may or may not be a registered Scouter.
- 2: A nominee should have rendered noteworthy service to the unit.

Procedure:

- 1: Forms need to be submitted to the District Adult Recognition committee through a District Professional or Unit Commissioner.

- 2: The following procedure is suggested for presentation ceremony:
 - a: The recipient is encouraged to attend the district's annual recognition dinner.
 - b: A district officer will explain the award and its significance.
 - c: A certificate suitable for framing and a patch will be awarded to each recipient.
 - d: Certificates will be presented at the Chippewa District dinner. If the recipient is not in attendance, the certificate and patch will be provided to the unit for presenting at an appropriate time of the unit's choosing.

3: Once this form is turned in, the award is final. There is no approval process for this award on the part of the District. It is up to the Unit to invite the award recipient to the dinner, purchase tickets for the dinner for the recipient and their guest.
